CFNKLS TREASURER'S REPORT for the 2020 AGM

As we all know, 2020 was a banner year of firsts, and hopefully, never agains! From work layoffs to cancelled family reunions, festivals, and community events, we have been forced to change the way we spend our time and our dollars. Covid-19 and the challenges it's brought to our lives have highlighted the importance of reaching out to those in the community adversely affected and isolated by the disease, to make a real and profound difference in their lives. Whether it's volunteering time, talent, emotional support, or a donation to a local charity, philanthropy provides a platform to turn feelings of helplessness into acts of empowerment and connection, and bring about real change in our communities. We are so thankful for our regular contributors to the endowment funds, and grateful to new donors who have seen the need for community-based support for local endeavors. As you can see in the numbers below, the number of memberships went down, but the actual donations to our operating funds increased substantially, from \$25 in 2019 to \$120 in 2020. We also saw an 87% drop in donations to our Treasure Hunt / Awareness event, although the number of Treasure Hunters from the community is on the rise, and we saw a lot of new online traffic on our Treasure Hunt website. We lost our \$1000 grant from CBT for board education, but we didn't have any in-person conferences to attend so our corresponding educational expenses were nil. And last but not least, we are extremely grateful to the Kootenay Savings Community Fund for their eleventh year of continuous support of CFNKLS' work. Our expenses dropped a little year over year. We continue to grant funds from the Community Small Grants budget, for various small-scale events and projects, suitable for a pandemic year.
